Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoint monitors individual and group performance at the end of the Lower Secondary programme. Many schools use Cambridge Checkpoint tests to assess learners in Year/Stage 9.

These external tests are marked by Cambridge International Education giving all parties extra confidence in the feedback received and shared with parents and candidates. The feedback generated also

- Allows parents to see how learners are performing against an international benchmark and in comparison to the rest of their class.
- Allows parents, teachers & Academic Management to easily monitor group and individual performance.

Candidates/Learners will receive a diagnostic feedback report on their academic performance with a Statement of achievement being awarded to all candidates.

The tests also enables schools to identify and address learning needs.

- mark achieved at strand and sub-strand/skill level
